Rescore Procedures

Rescore requests should be initiated at the test center. Please follow the following procedures:

- a. Candidates requesting a rescore will receive the corresponding form from the test center where they took the test (or the nearest test center). Candidates fill out the form, hand it in at the center, and pay the requisite fee at the test center.
- b. Candidates who want to request a rescore of their test results will have up to one month after the results have been issued by the University of Michigan.
- c. The test center will send to the University of Michigan:
 1. complete name of the candidate
 2. candidate's registration number
 3. candidate's birthdate
 4. test location
 5. Sections that need to be rescored
 6. Rescore payment
- d. Cambridge Michigan Language Assessments will print the rescore result and deliver it to the test center for distribution.
- e. Candidates can request a rescore of the objective section of the test (listening and GVR/GCVR) or the writing section.

Please be aware that due to the electronic scoring of bubble sheets, scores on the listening and GCVR sections generally will not change.
